



ATLANTIC SUNRISE

The Atlantic Sunrise project reached a significant milestone last week when the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued the draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS), concluding that any environmental impacts “*would be reduced to less-than-significant levels with the implementation of Transco’s proposed mitigation and the additional measures recommended in the draft EIS.*” For your convenience the complete DEIS can be found [here](#).

Since we first began the pre-filing process in 2014, we have changed more than half of the original project route as a direct result of feedback from landowners and other key stakeholders. That is why we encourage all interested stakeholders to submit comments during the 60-day public comment period, which is now open and closes on **June 27, 2016**.

Before the comment period closes, FERC will also hold four public meetings in June throughout the project area. Any person wishing to comment on the DEIS is encouraged to attend.
